The approved committee will then begin the process of looking for candidates for a Pastor. The committee will keep everyone informed of their progress.

♥ Visiting with the Pastor,

As we begin this new year, I am reminded of one of my favorite Bible verses from Proverbs 21:1 *"The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, like the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes."* The Lord used this verse with me many years ago to remind me that He was the Lord, that He was in charge of all the tomorrows, and that he could change my direction at any time! As we get physically older in life, have you noticed how hard it is for your body to be as flexible as it used to be as a child? Small children are so flexible, and they never need to attempt stretching exercises, but as the child grows into adulthood, they have to continually stretch those tightening muscles in a feeble attempt to stay limber. The church can become very stiff with age and set in her ways needing some stretching, even though it may hurt at first, but in time - it becomes easier.

♥ Pastor Search Committee ♥

On January 15th, I outlined some major events for 2017. The first event is the need for the Nominating Committee to select a Pastor Search Committee for a successful succession for the next pastor to follow me. The committee will consist of seven people with two being alternates and the other five forming the committee. The two alternates can listen, give ideas but they cannot vote on the committee. The Nominating Committee will meet on January 29th, to select the Search Committee. On February 5th, at the end of the service, all church members will be able to cast their votes of approval or disapproval for the selected committee members. I have already given some guidance over the past year to a select group of leaders about pastoral succession, and I am sure their direction will be most valuable.

This Pastor Search Committee will keep the church informed as to their discoveries in this process so the church body will not be left in the dark as to their direction. I believe this can be a most exciting time for the entire church as she looks to the future. Remember, we need to stretch a little more as we get older in order to remain limber and ready for the Lord to direct our heart as He does the rivers of water.

♥ New Worship Schedule ♥

On March 19th, we will begin a new worship schedule. After having discussed this with the Administrative Council, the Deacon body and the Church body, we will be changing our worship schedule on Sunday, March 19th. There are many

reasons for this. The primary reason will be to maximize that which the Lord has provided for us. We have been blessed with people, their talents and gifts, and the facilities needed to be a united body of believers in these days before us so that we can maximize our adoration and glorification of our Lord as one body. The worship service will be what is called a blended service. There is nothing radical or peculiar about this, and it is believed that you will discover how much you will enjoy worshipping the Lord with a more blended service.

Our Annual Mission Offering Collection Continues

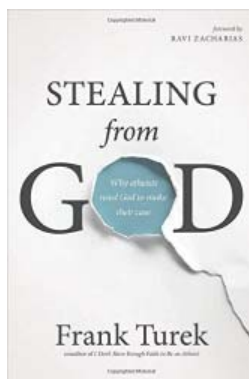
2016-2017 Goal: \$38,500

Nearly 1 in every 68 children born today will be diagnosed with autism.


Our church is in the process of beginning a partnership with **AFA Academy**. Plans are for this program to use our Education and Children's Building during the school calendar year beginning in August 2017.
