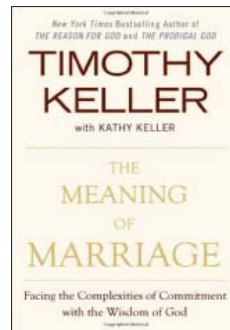
Additionally, we will begin Wednesday night **"Bible Drill"** and **"Parents of Children and Youth Bible Study."**

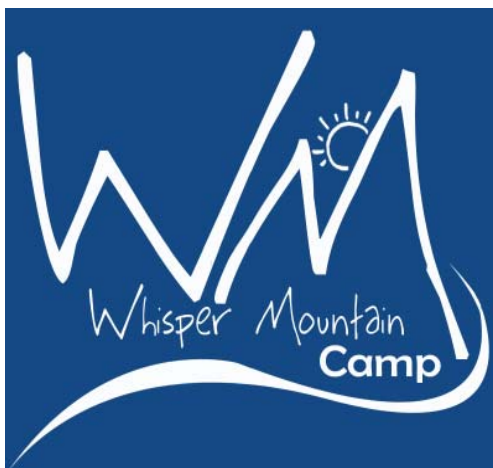

HOMEMADE COOKIES AND PRAYER SUPPORT ARE NEEDED

About 30 men from our area will minister in the S.C. Department of Corrections medium-security prison at Ridgeland, SC, taking God's Word to the men who live in these facilities in an effort to reach these men for Christ who do not already know Him, and encourage those who do know from Thursday, January 12, through Sunday, January 15, during "God's Special Time" weekend.

PRAYER SUPPORT

A prayer chain is being organized for around-the-clock prayer throughout the "God's Special Time" weekend. Could you pray for 30 minutes or more? If so, please let us know by filing out the form on the reverse side indicating the time(s) you plan to be in prayer when the Kairos Prison Ministry weekend is taking place. Return the prayer guide form to the church office in Sunday's offering plate or hand deliver to the Family Life Center desk.

You can pray any time, in 30-minute increments or more, during the 24-hours each day between 4:00 PM Thursday, January 12, through the end of the event at 4:00 PM, Sunday, January 15. It is our goal to have every 30 minutes filled with someone in prayer for the weekend. Your name will be added to the time-line of all the names from area churches who have committed to pray for this ministry, printed, and then posted for all the men to see just how many will be praying for them.

You will find "A Prayer Guide for Kairos and for the Incarcerated Participants" in the foyers of our worship centers to assist you.

BAKE COOKIES

Home-baked cookies are a tangible expression of God's love and His concern for inmates who seldom encounter love in their daily lives. The cookies will be given to all inmates as an expression of God's love and impact them with the love of Jesus.

Cookies are to be home-baked by specific recipes in order to comply with prison guidelines for preparation and packaging. The back of the Prayer Guide has recipes for Peanut Butter, Sugar, Molasses and Chewy Oatmeal cookies and packaging directions. The recipe sheets and Prayer Guide are available in the foyers of our worship centers.

Pray as you bake the cookies that the Holy Spirit will touch the hearts of these men. Through prayer, the cookies you bake will become an instrument of God's love, too.

The deadline for returning cookies to the Family Life Center is Sunday through Wednesday, January 8 - 11, 2016 - NO LATER THAN Wednesday, JANUARY 11TH.

We realize that hosting Disaster Relief teams causes a lot of extra work for the church staff and members, and inconveniences or even disrupts the normal operations, parking, and many other aspects of church life. If your church incurred unusual expenses due to our volunteers using your facility, please make us aware of it.


The willing spirit of the members and staff of First Baptist was truly a blessing to the volunteers who were able to minister in your area because of your support. We particularly appreciate all the assistance and support given by Chuck Workman.

Disaster Relief ministries include giving both spiritual and physical help to people in crisis. Work is still being done, but as of early December, the hurricane response across our state resulted in:

- 10 professions of faith
- 175 gospel presentations
- 2,499 chaplaincy/ministry contacts
- 292 Bibles distributed
- 624 chainsaw jobs
- 20 complete flood clean-up jobs, plus 135 additional homes worked on
- 113,405 meals prepared

We appreciate so much the role you have played in bringing help, hope, and healing to people who experienced the devastation of the hurricane. May the Lord bless you richly as you serve Him.
