




June 3rd-7th - Week of Champions (No Wednesday Night Activity)

FROM THE MINISTER OF MUSIC AND EDUCATION. . .

Just a few weeks ago, I had the privilege of going to a Pastor/Minister of Education Essentials training event with our pastor. We were able to experience what, I thought, was a great time of learning and fellowship, not only with each other, but with 18 other church leaders and the staff at LifeWay in Nashville. I know that you already know this, but I have been reminded afresh and anew of how blessed we are as a church to have Brett Myers as our pastor. He truly has a love for the people of our church and our community, and a heart for seeing lost people ushered into the Kingdom of God through the life and witness of God's people.

Our training in Nashville was absolutely some of the best teaching that I have experienced focusing on creating a Disciple-Making Culture in the local church. Some of the sessions at the conference focused on "Ingredients for Disciple-Making", "Team Unity", "Accomplishing the Great Commission Through Sunday School", "Staff Relationships", "The Four Disciplines of Execution", and "Essentials for an Evangelistic Sunday School". As we continue to be encouraged by our pastor to be sharing our faith where God has planted us, I believe that our church is primed and ready to begin the process of praying toward, striving for, and working toward having a Sunday School Ministry that is both evangelistic and "making Biblical disciples."

As we look toward some possible changes in the life and ministry of our Sunday School in the future, I hope and pray that our Sunday School class members and teachers alike will be open and receptive to any new direction as the Lord leads. Implementing change can sometimes be like trying to eat an elephant – the only way you can eat an elephant – one bite at a time! Thank you in advance for trusting the leadership of our church as we seek to "Make Biblical disciples who love, serve, and share Christ with all people." In the words of Allan Taylor, "Sunday School and evangelism are both hard work. They are not easy or often convenient; but when utilized, they bring forth fruit, eternal fruit, fruit that remains."

SABBATICAL

Quite a number of our church members (especially my choir members) have been asking about my upcoming sabbatical. The most common question I have received has been: "So...where are you going for six weeks?!" Interesting question – especially since we have two dogs and a cat! Just to clarify, our pastor and personnel committee were very gracious in offering me the opportunity to take this time of extended leave from the church – a time of my own choosing. With all of the demands of the music ministry during the fall, winter and spring, it seemed best to take the time away during the summer. So, my sabbatical will officially begin on Monday, June 17th, and will end on Sunday, July 28th. Traditionally, the sabbatical has been a time of not only rest, but also a time of personal study, training, and edification. So actually, over half of the time, I will be at home...taking care of those two dogs and our cat...and working on (probably) an extended "honey do" list! I will be working on a couple of projects that I have coming up this fall at the church during my time away. Angela and I will also be going to the Billy Graham Training Center at "The Cove" in Asheville, North Carolina, for a



guided personal spiritual retreat. And I will also be returning to the Westminster Choir College in Princeton, New Jersey, to take a graduate-level course in Vocal Pedagogy – hoping to add to my vocal knowledge and my ability to help my choir members (and myself) pursue healthy singing practices. Finally, we did have a request from Rachel and Natalie....so we will be going to spend a few days at Disney World!



During my time away, we will have some truly outstanding leadership for both the choir rehearsals on Wednesday nights and also for leading worship on Sunday mornings. Our own Nancy Forbes will be filling in for me during the very last week of my sabbatical – Thank you, Nancy! And for four of the weeks I am

gone, you are in for a special treat – our former minister of music, Mark Blankenship will be returning to Hilton Head to lead our church in worship – Thank you, Mark! I am thrilled to be leaving our choir and congregation in such wonderfully capable hands.

I certainly covet your prayers as we are away – and you can be assured of our prayers for you as our church family as well. We will miss you...but we will be looking forward to a wonderful new season of ministry together when we return!



The Origin of Father's Day

One Sunday in 1909, Sonora Smart Dodd listened to a sermon honoring mothers. Her mother had died some years before, so her father had raised her by himself. Dodd wondered why there wasn't a day to honor fathers, so she arranged a tribute to her father at a church in Spokane, Washington. The date was June 19, 1910. Many people believe this was the beginning of Father's Day.

Another account holds that a West Virginia church held a tribute service for fathers in 1908, following a mine explosion that killed 360 men. Regardless of which story is correct, President Calvin Coolidge was the first president to designate a special day to honor fathers. In 1924, he proclaimed the third Sunday in June as Father's Day.

Baptisms



The Beck and Lindstrom Families were so happy with their son's decisions to follow Jesus and to be baptized. Each young man was given a Baptism Certificate to commemorate the day and also a Bible, so they can continue to grow in the Lord.

Pastor Brett charged the church to pray for these young men and their families.

At the starting gate

"There's a good reason they call these ceremonies 'commencement exercises,'" Utah Senator Orrin Hatch once said. "Graduation is not the end; it's the beginning." The same is true of baptism. Both events are often approached as an end point reached with relief: "Well, at least that's done!" With the degree — or salvation — in hand, some people feel no further need for education — or spiritual growth.

Just remember: You're at the starting gate, not the finish line. Well-wishers encourage new grads, "Don't stop now; you're on a roll. Even greater things are ahead!" And Hebrews 12:1 (NRSV) urges the baptized, "Run with perseverance the race that is set before [you]." While a diploma bears the seal of the graduate's school, Christians themselves are sealed with the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13; 4:30) and the cross of Christ. To take full advantage of each, we must continue learning and growing.
