

We've taken advantage of some wonderful opportunities as we ministered through VBS, Week of Champions, Youth Camp, the One Island/One Community event, and still ahead at the time of my writing, is the Community Block Party. Thank you church for being a church who engages our community. We need to continue, ever increasingly, to be a church that makes a difference in our community. We should be so impacting that, if we ever (God-forbid) ceased to exist, an impact would be felt even by those who have never even walked through our doors.

who's your **ONE**?

"Who's Your One?" Emphasis

In light of all we have done to reach out corporately, let me also encourage and challenge you with this thought. If we truly want to make a difference in those people who are still lost in our area, we need to reach out individually. Simply put, we need every church member taking the Gospel to their friends and neighbors. That's the essence of this "Who's Your One" emphasis...to get believers personally acting upon the Great Commission. I believe this WYO emphasis can be incredibly effective for one reason: it's Biblical. Regardless of your spiritual giftedness or your personality type or the perceived power of your testimony, every single follower of Christ has the responsibility (and much more, the giftedness) to lead others to Christ. As we enter the fall season and many of our schedules return to a norm, be intentional in looking for opportunities to reach your One.



Church Strategy

I hope you are chewing on the concepts we are journeying through in our sermon series, which is

following the progression of our Church Strategy Map. As we've now wrestled through challenges from the Scriptures to build intentional relationships (RELATE) with people for the purpose of the Gospel, and then looked at the many passages on reaching people (REACH), we are transitioning beginning August 18 into a sub-series in which we will look at our responsibility both as the church and as individual believers to RAISE new believers. I believe Scripture calls us all not just to be about evangelism, but also about discipleship...helping those we have led to Christ to become fully mature in their faith. I remind you of a favorite quote from Dr. Don Wilton, "Evangelism is not complete until the evangelized becomes the evangelist." Over these next several weeks, we will look at what we can do both corporately and individually to raise new believers. As we do, keep at it with your 10:02 Prayer. Nothing significant happens without prayer.


10:02 Prayer Emphasis








Kitchen Cleaning Day
